Overview:

Within the vestibular field, there can be a disconnect between diagnostic vestibular assessments and result interpretation for practicing audiologists. This is more evident for clinicians who are new to vestibular assessment and have limited experience.

This masterclass is designed for clinicians who have a reasonable knowledge of vestibular assessment and rehabilitation but are looking to build on this foundation.

This masterclass will integrate theoretical and practical components that brings together the core elements of balance assessments, how to perform the tests and how to interpret the results through case studies. The masterclass encourages interaction from participants who will choose the assessments they deem relevant to the case and make clinical decisions on what happens next.
